The Department of Botany in association with the Bhoomithrasena Club of Little Flower College (Autonomous), Guruvayur organized a nature study trip titled “**Feel the Nature – A Trip to KFRI, Peechi**” on 15 September 2025. The programme was conducted to provide students with direct exposure to forest ecosystems and to encourage interest in environmental conservation.

### Objectives of the Programme

- To create awareness about forest biodiversity and conservation.
- To provide students with field-level learning experiences.

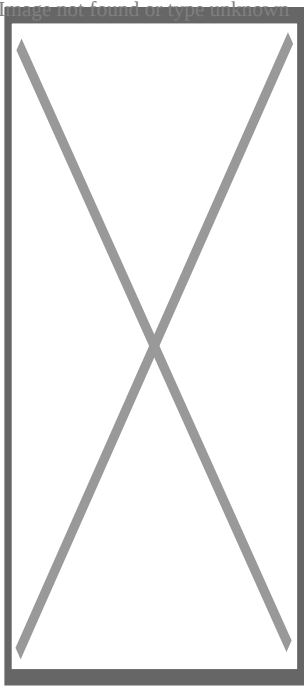

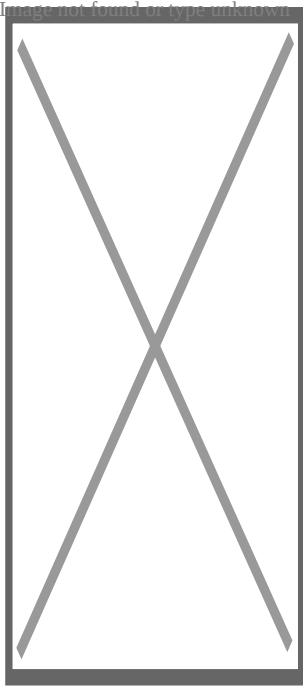
